Information and Rules

- This gymkhana is run under PCA NSW rules – <http://pcansw.org.au/policies/pca-handbook>
- Gear check will be available at the arena gate from 8:30am. If you change your gear, you will need to present yourself to a gear checker (in yellow vest) to be re-checked.
- The Bungendore pony club committee reserves the right to amend events and age groups on the day
- One horse-one-rider, one rider-one-horse
- Full pony club uniform to be worn, club jackets are permitted.
- **NO DOGS ON THE GROUNDS.**
- All persons entering the grounds do so at their own risk. The Bungendore Pony Club and its Committee will not be held responsible for injury or illness to any rider, horse, spectator or property.
- All families will be required to provide a helper for the sporting and other events throughout the day.
- If the event is to be cancelled, a notice will be made on the Zone 16 Facebook page.
- Current Show jump grading card required – no card, no jump.
- 'Introductory Grade' Show Jumping will only do one round to optimum time in the AM7 and are not eligible for the six-bar.
- Led riders are not eligible to participate in show jumping.

Entry Fees – includes sporting, jumping and challenge.

Pre-entry: via Global Entries \$25 per rider, \$70 for family of 3 or more riders.
